**HUSKINS COOPERATIVE PROGRAM AGREEMENT**

This agreement between the Board of Trustees of a North Carolina Community College and a Board of Education of a North Carolina Public or Private School System or High School is to establish a joint program of college credit courses for qualified high school students in accordance with NC General Statutes 115D-20(4), 23 NCAC 2C. 0305 and, NC Community College State Board approved policies and procedures, and applicable North Carolina Community College System Office numbered memoranda.

**Statement of Purpose(s)**

The purpose of this agreement is to provide curriculum courses to Warren County Schools student population that can be used as high school elective credit as well as college credit at the community college level. The college will extend course offerings to high school students that are not otherwise available.

**Criteria for selecting students**

The "qualified high school student" must be in grades 9-12, have good academic standing, meet the college's Placement Test requirements and benefit from advanced level instruction.
