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Beginning with the 2013 tax year, tax filers who, because of IRS identity theft, are denied an IRS Tax Return Transcript using one of the regular processes will be referred to the Identity Protection Specialized Unit (IPSU) toll-free number at 1-800-908-4490. Filers who believe they are victims of identity theft do not need to be referred to the IPSU; they may call the number directly or go to the ID theft website on [irs.gov](http://irs.gov). After the IPSU authenticates the tax filer’s identity, the tax filer can request that the IRS mail to the tax filer an alternate paper tax return transcript. The alternate transcript is known as the TRDBV (Transcript Data Base View).
