

## MULTIPLE MEASURES FOR PLACEMENT

*Revised August 2016*

Students who meet the Multiple Measures for Placement guidelines may be exempt from placement testing. If you think you are eligible for this waiver, you should submit your official high school transcript to the VGCC Admissions & Records as soon as possible.

1. **If you graduated from high school within 5 years of applying to VGCC, you may be eligible.**  
Continue to the next question. *If NO – you are not eligible.*
2. **If your high GPA was 2.6 or greater out of a possible 4.0 (unweighted), you may be eligible.**  
Continue to the next question. *If NO – you are not eligible.*
3. **If you completed 4 math courses, you may be eligible.**  
Continue to the next question. *If NO – you are not eligible.*
4. **If the 4<sup>th</sup> math you completed was one listed below, you may be eligible.**  
Continue to the next question. *If NO – you are not eligible.*
