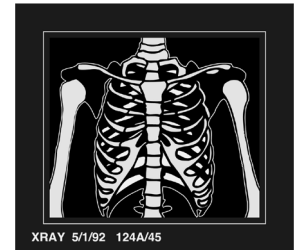

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS FALL SEMESTERS



MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of the Vance-Granville Community College (VGCC) Radiography program is to provide our students with a comprehensive education in radiography to prepare them to enter the radiographic profession as a competent entry-level radiographer.

ADMISSION PROCEDURES

Students are admitted to the Radiography program (A45700) in accordance with policies set by VGCC. Each applicant is required to meet the minimum admission eligibility requirements as set by the College. Meeting minimum eligibility requirements does not guarantee admission into the program, only an opportunity for consideration.

The selection process for this program includes PROGRAM APPLICATION Completion (must be completed for consideration for the Radiography Program), Points Allocation, and Acceptance Status (determined in May). **Regulations, procedures, and course requirements are subject to change as necessary and without prior notice.**

NOTE: This program is offered at the South Campus in Creedmoor.

PROCESS FOR PROGRAM ADMISSION

1. Apply to VGCC. Designate Radiography as the desired program of study. **Deadline for application to VGCC for the Radiography program is the last business day of December 31st by 11:59 p.m.** Applicants will be placed into a Pre-Health Curriculum (Associate in General Education-General Science A10300S), until selected into the program.
2. Submit official transcripts. Student must be eligible to enroll in ENG 111 and MAT 110 in order to be eligible for admission into the Radiography program. Students that need to take a co-requisite with either ENG 111 or MAT 110 are not eligible for admission.
3. Complete BIO 163 or BIO 168 & 169 with a grade of "C" or higher.
4. Meet with an Academic Advisor. Please email studentsuccess@vgcc.edu or visit www.vgcc.edu/advisors for more information about contacting an advisor. The following is required to be eligible for admission:
 - a. The student **MUST** achieve a cumulative GPA (grade point average) of 2.8 or higher as calculated on the last business day of March. A grade of "C" or higher is required for all general education courses. BIO course(s) required for the program must be completed within 10 years of the deadline.
5. Schedule a meeting with the Consultation Committee for the Radiography Program.
6. The PROGRAM APPLICATION PROCESS deadline is the last business day of March.

CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK: VGCC cautions applicants that the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) National Examination for certification, on its registration form, asks the following question: "Have you ever been convicted of a misdemeanor or felony (excluding a minor traffic violation)?" The ARRT reserves the right to refuse to allow graduates to sit for the registry based on their past criminal record. If this will hinder your progression, please visit the VGCC Admissions Office for more information on alternative programs of study at VGCC.

Students will be notified of acceptance or selection as an alternate beginning in May.
