LPN C/O 2025



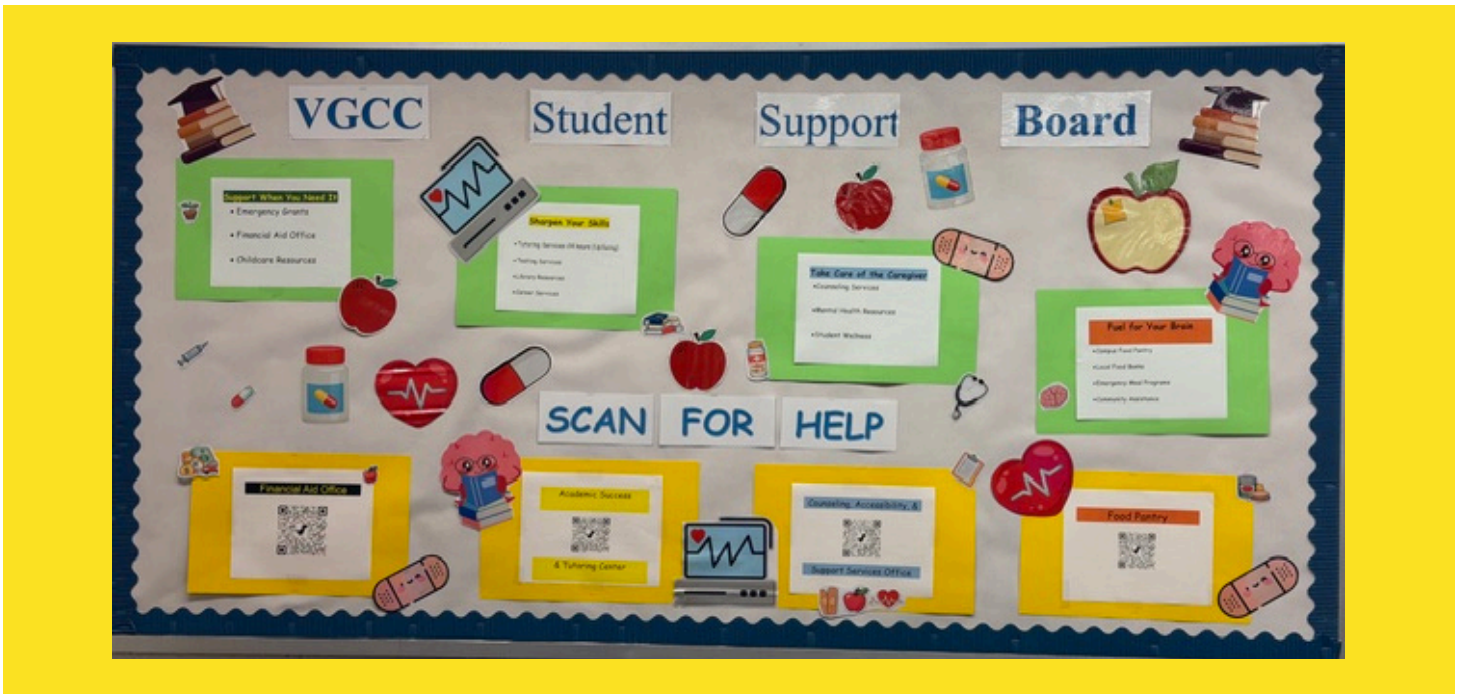
