Ranking

To be considered for ranking purposes, courses must be completed before the application deadline.

Certifications, licensures, or residency status information must be submitted before the application deadline to be considered for ranking.

- BIO 168 and BIO 169 must be within 5 years of the application date.
- Nursing applicants are required to complete, BIO-168 and BIO-169 (ADN, LPN to ADN Transition, and RIBN applicants), PSY-150, and ENG-111 prior to applying to the program.
- BIO 168 and BIO 169 must be completed with a minimum grade of C for eligibility; ranking points for BIO 168 and BIO 169 are awarded as listed below.

Points System for Course Grades: Standard courses use A=4, B=3, C=2 (grade multiplied by credits = points awarded). BIO 168 and BIO 169 use A=6, B=4, C=2 for ranking.
